It is with profound regret and sorrow that we inform you of the death of our good friend
and Honorary Vice President

Mr. Hermann Schiechl

At the time of his passing he was ISU Honorary Member, a role to which he was elected
at the 40th Ordinary Congress held in Colorado Springs, United States in 1984.

Mr. Hermann Schiechl passed away in Germany on February 1st, 2016 at the age of 92.

Born on January 5th, 1924 in München Hermann Schiechl began his involvement in
skating as an athlete competing in Ice Dance together with Erika Burger his future wife.
Shortly after ending his sporting career Mr. Schiechl was elected in 1954 as board
member of the German Skating Union. He held this function during a total of 20 years
and in 1974 he was appointed Honorary Chairman of the German Skating Union.

Mr. Schiechl was subsequently first elected to the International Skating Union Ice Dance
Technical Committee from 1957 to 1967. He was elected as a Figure Skating Council
Member in 1967. In 1980 he was elected Vice President of Figure Skating and served in
this capacity on the ISU Council until 1984, before retiring from the ISU for professional
reasons.

Mr. Schiechl is survived by his wife and son.

The ISU pays tribute to Hermann Schiechl's devoted service to the ISU and asks
Members to remember him with affection.
