## Communication No. 1480

### Decision of Court of Arbitration for Sport

Further to ISU Communication No. 1453 concerning the decision of the ISU Disciplinary Commission dated June 8, 2007 in the case of Anthony Lobello (USA), Mr. Lobello filed an appeal with the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS).

The CAS has issued the following decision, dated December 6, 2007:

1. The appeal filed by Mr Anthony Lobello on 29 June 2007 against a decision of the ISU Disciplinary Commission dated 8 June 2007 is upheld.
2. The decision of the ISU Disciplinary Commission of 8 June 2007 to impose a period of ineligibility on Mr. Lobello is reversed and annulled.
3. This award is rendered without costs except for the Court Office fee of CHF 500 (five hundred Swiss francs) already paid by Mr Lobello, which shall be retained by the Court of Arbitration for Sport.
4. Each part shall bear its own legal and other costs.
5. All other or further claims are dismissed.

There is no further appeal from this decision.
