## Communication No. 1589

### OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES 2010 ENTRIES/PARTICIPATION SINGLE & PAIR SKATING AND ICE DANCE (in addition to Communication No. 1568 and 1563)

#### A) Entries

##### 1. Allocated entries

The remaining entries for the Single & Pair Skating and the Ice Dance competitions at the 2010 Olympic Winter Games (OWG) have been allocated according to Rule 400 A. paragraph 4 and 400 B. paragraph 4, after the Nebelhorn Trophy, Olympic Qualifying Competition in Oberstdorf, Germany, held on September 24-27, 2009.

Only NOCs/Members which had not already qualified for entries in each discipline were eligible for the remaining entries for the 2010 Olympic Winter Games.

Entries to 2010 Olympic Winter Games are in all cases awarded to NOCs/Members and not individual/named skaters.

However, only skaters fulfilling both ISU and IOC citizenship/residency requirements may be entered. According to the Olympic Charter, Rule 42, only citizens of the NOC/Member may be entered. Furthermore, according to the Bye-Law to Rule 42, paragraph 2 of the Olympic Charter, at least 3 years must have passed since the entered competitor last represented his former country/Member.

## 3. Qualification for Final Free Skating

Based on the results of the Short Program in Singles and in accordance with Rule 400. A, paragraph 1, the twenty-four (24) best placed competitors only shall qualify for the Final Free Skating. All 20 Pairs qualify for the Final Free Skating. In Ice Dance, all 24 Ice Dance couples qualify for the Original Dance and Free Dance. The results shall be calculated in the usual manner in accordance with Rules 353.

## B) Judges

### 1. The following NOCs/Members may send Judges

The draw for Judges for the OWG was done at the Nebelhorn Trophy 2009, in Oberstdorf/Germany on September 26, 2009, according to ISU Communication No. 1563, respectively Rule 402 as amended in this Communication.

*Explanation of the chart:*

1 = Judge drawn for first segment (Short Program/Compulsory Dance)

2 = Judge drawn for second segment (Free Skating/Original Dance)

In accordance with ISU Communication No. 1563, Rule 402, paragraph 1.b) the Judges marked with "2" are seeded for the second segment and the panel will be completed with additional 5 Judges drawn amongst the 9 Judges (marked with "1") who are judging the first segment. For the third segment in Ice Dance, ISU Communication No. 1563, Rule 402, paragraph 1f) applies.

### 2. Judges by name

Further to ISU Communication No. 1563 (Rule 402, paragraph 3), the names of the Judges drawn must be sent to the ISU Secretariat, 10 days after the publication of this Communication (**October 9, 2009**) by using the attached form.

### 3. Travel arrangements for Judges

Nominated Judges must urgently arrange their own travel to Vancouver. As per IOC Guidelines, Judges must be present on site at least 3 days before their first event (earliest arrival date: Thursday, February 11, 2010). Therefore, Judges nominated for the Pair Skating Competition, should arrive on Thursday, February 11, 2010. Judges officiating in the other disciplines (Men, Ice Dance, Ladies) may arrive later but at least 3 days before their first event. The earliest possible departure is after the Round Table discussion but latest Sunday, February 28, 2010.

Once the flight has been booked, the Judges shall send a reimbursement request to the ISU Secretariat by indicating the cost of travel in the enclosed form and by attaching a copy of the e-ticket and respective invoice. Flights will be reimbursed up to a maximum amount of CAD 1'000 for flights originating from North America, and up to CAD 2'500 for other International flights. If the flights are more expensive than the indicated amounts, The Judge or Member must contact the ISU before booking.

### C) Entry procedures/deadlines

- **October 9, 2009:** Entry by Name for Judges form (see attached) must be sent by all Members which have been drawn with a Judge.
- **October 30, 2009:** Entry by Number forms must be submitted by all NOCs/Members which have been allocated an entry to the OWG, including those with stand-by entries. These forms must be sent by NOCs/Members and received by VANOC no later than October 30, 2009, according to their instructions and a copy must also be sent to the ISU Secretariat. In the case that not all NOCs/Members use their full quota of entries, the available places will be reallocated to the stand-by NOCs/Members. The respective stand-by NOCs/Members will be informed by the ISU immediately after October 30, 2009.
- **January 11, 2010:** Entry by Name forms (see attached) must be sent by all NOCs/Members which have been allocated an entry to the OWG, including those with remaining stand-by entries, and be received by the ISU Secretariat only, no later than January 11, 2010. In the case that not all NOCs/Members use their full quota of entries and the available entries are reallocated to NOCs/Members with remaining stand-by entries, the NOCs/Members receiving these reallocated entries will be informed by the ISU Secretariat by January 19, 2010.
- **February 1, 2010:** VANOC Entry by Name forms must be submitted by all NOCs/Members which have been allocated an entry to the OWG. These forms must be sent by NOCs and received by VANOC no later than February 1, 2010 according to their instructions and a copy also sent to the ISU Secretariat. After this date, in principle no entries can be transferred from one NOC/Member to another NOC/Member.
