SINGLE & PAIR SKATING

ISU Recognized Single-Pair Judges' Seminars 2008

After receiving Members' applications, the ISU recognized the following Judges Seminars:

- Korea, Seoul, April 25 – 27, 2008
- Poland, Warsaw, May 30 – June 1, 2008
- France, Courchevel, August 27 – 31, 2008 (in conjunction with Junior Grand Prix Event)
- Switzerland, Winterthur, September 4 – 7, 2008
- Croatia, Zagreb, November 13 – 16, 2008 (in conjunction with “Golden Spin”)

Members are also reminded that the Single and Pair Skating Technical Committee may recognize national seminars organized by a Member as official seminars for the purpose of Rule 410, paragraph 10. b, 12. f), 13. f) and Rule 425, paragraphs 9.a) (ii), 9.b) (ii), 10.c) and 11.c). Moderators designated by the ISU must conduct these Seminars. If a Seminar is organized in conjunction with an International Competition, the participants at the Seminar cannot also serve as Referees, Judges or Coaches at the competition. The organizing Member must make the application to the ISU for recognition.

Members wishing to nominate Referees and/or Judges (in Singles and Pairs) to participate in an ISU Recognized Seminar, or the ISU Referees/Judges themselves, may make an application to the ISU Secretariat, with copies to the Host Member and the Chair of the Single and Pair Skating Technical Committee, not later than six weeks prior to the scheduled date of the Seminar. The Host Member must also send to the ISU Secretariat, with a copy to the Chair of the Single and Pair Skating Technical Committee, the names of those of its own Referees, Judges and Coaches who will attend the Seminar.

These Seminars are primarily for the Referees/Judges of the organizing Members. However Referees/Judges of other Members (not more than 2 per Member) can also attend subject to the availability of places.

Language

All Seminars will be conducted in English.

Expenses

The responsibility for the expenses of an ISU Recognized Seminar will be allocated as follows:

- 1) The travel expenses of the participating Referees, Judges and Coaches will be borne by their respective Members, or by the Referees/Judges themselves in case of direct application (not through the Members).
- 2) The living expenses (rooms and meals) of the participating ISU/International Referees, Judges and Coaches (other than the Coach requested by the ISU) will be borne by their respective Members or by the Referees/Judges themselves in case of direct application (not through the Members).
- 3) The travel and living expenses of the Moderators will be borne by the ISU.

Deadline

The deadlines for sending the applications are:

- Korea, Seoul: **March 14, 2008**
- Poland, Warsaw: **April 18, 2008**
- France, Courchevel: **July 16, 2008**
- Switzerland, Winterthur: **July 24, 2008**
- Croatia, Zagreb: **October 2, 2008**
