SINGLE & PAIR SKATING

I. ISU Recognized Single-Pair Seminar 2006

After receiving Member's applications the ISU recognized the following Single-Pair National Judges Seminar:

Taipei City, Chinese Taipei, October 11 – 15, 2006

This Seminar is primarily for the Judges and Referees of the Host Member. However, Referees and Judges of other Members needing to attend a Seminar may, upon application to the ISU Secretariat (attn: Miss Céline de Joffrey, email: dejoffrey@isu.ch, fax: +41 21 612 66 77), with copies to the Host Member and the Chairperson of the Single & Pair Skating Technical Committee, also attend, subject to the availability of places.

These applications must be received at least six (6) weeks prior to the start of the Seminar. The Seminar will be conducted in English. All participating Referees, Judges and Coaches must have a working knowledge of English.

Expenses

The responsibility for the expenses of an ISU Recognized National Judges Seminar will be allocated as follows (see also ISU Communication 1357) :

- a) The administrative expenses (use of ice surface, classroom and all supporting equipment/facilities) will be borne by the Host Member.
- b) The travel and living expenses of the moderator/s of the Seminar designated to serve by the Single and Pair Skating Technical Committee will be borne by the Host Member.
- c) The travel expenses of the participating Referees, Judges and Coaches will be borne by their respective Members, or by the ISU Referees/Judges themselves in case of direct application (not through the Members).
- d) The living expenses (rooms and meals) of the participating ISU/International Referees, Judges and Coaches (other than the Coach/es requested by the ISU) will be borne by their respective Members or by the ISU Referees/Judges themselves in case of direct application (not through the Members).

II. Clarification on Pairs Free Skating

A well balanced Pairs Free Program must contain maximum of 1 Solo Jump and maximum of 1 Jump Combination or Sequence.

In case of both these jump elements executed as Solo Jumps, the second of them will be considered as a part of a not successfully executed jump sequence and counted as a jump sequence with only one jump executed (to be consistent with Single Skating).

III. Correction to the ISU Communication No. 1396

The following correction in the Scale of Values should be made:

Pair Skating, Lifts, Groups 3, 4, 5 (except Axel Lasso), all Levels, “+” GOEs:
the numerical values of these GOEs should be changed as follows:

+1	0,5
+2	1,0
+3	1,5

(correction of typing error).
