Entries ISU Championships 2007

1. SPEED SKATING

a) European Speed Skating Championships 2007

In accordance with Rule 208, paragraph 5 c), the following countries may enter more than 1 competitor:

c) World Junior Speed Skating Championships 2007

The entry quotas for the World Junior Speed Skating Championships 2007 are for each ISU Member 3 Ladies and 3 Men, and one substitute per category, in accordance with Rule 208, paragraph 7. For each Member participating in the Team Pursuit event, their team must be selected among this maximum of 4 entered participants.

d) World Sprint Speed Skating Championships 2007

In accordance with Rule 208, paragraph 6, the following countries may enter more than 2 competitors:

4. ENTRY DEADLINES**a) Speed Skating**

In accordance with Rule 208, paragraphs 8 and 9, the number of competitors and substitutes, if possible with a preliminary list of names, must be entered 18 days before the first day of the Championship. Post entries are not allowed. The ISU Members are seriously requested to enter only that number of skaters that they actually intend to send to the Championships concerned. The names of the competitors and of a corresponding set of substitutes must be communicated to the organizing committee not later than three (3) days before the first day of the Championships.

b) Short Track Speed Skating

In accordance with Rule 295, paragraphs 4 b), c) and e), the number of competitors, substitutes, coaches and team leaders shall be entered at least four weeks before the first day of the ISU Event concerned. Members are seriously requested to enter only the number of skaters they actually intend to send to the ISU Event concerned. The names of the competitors and substitutes names per category with their International Registration Number shall be communicated to the organizing committee at the latest on the fifth day before the first day of the ISU Event concerned. Post Entries are not allowed. The organizing committee will immediately notify the Member concerned that the entry has arrived late and that the entry is therefore not accepted.

c) Single and Pair Skating & Ice Dancing

In accordance with Rule 378, paragraph 1, entries by name must reach the Sport Director Figure Skating and the Organizing Committee simultaneously by 21 days before the first day (opening and first draws) of the Championships concerned.

d) Synchronized Skating

In accordance with Rule 768, paragraph 1, entries of teams must reach the Sport Director Figure Skating and the Organizing Committee simultaneously by 21 days before the first day (opening and first draws) of the Championships concerned.

The exact deadlines are issued in the Official Announcement for each ISU Championships.
