Judges draw by number for ISU Figure Skating and Synchronized Skating Championships

In accordance with Rules 582 (Single & Pair Skating), 660 (Ice Dancing) and 972 (Synchronized Skating) the draw for Judges by number for the above-mentioned Championships was held on October 12, at the Hotel Bristol in Geneva in the presence of Mr. David Dore, ISU Vice-President Figure Skating, Mr. Peter Krick, Chair Sports Directorate, Mrs. Felicitas Babusikova, Sports Director Figure Skating, Mr. Alexander Lakernik, Single & Pair Skating Technical Committee Chair and Mr. Roland Gerber, certified auditor from BDO Visura.

The results of the draw are as follows:

In accordance with Rule 582, paragraph 6d), the Judges marked with “2” are seeded for the second segment and the panel will be completed with additional 8 Judges drawn amongst the 12 Judges (marked with “1”) who are judging the first segment.
