Trial Judging

An official Trial Judging, as per rule 818 paragraphs 9a) (i) and 10c) will be conducted by the ISU Synchronized Skating Technical Committee in connection with the French Cup, ISU International Synchronized Skating Competition for Seniors and Juniors, which be held in:

Rouen, France, February 1st – 4th, 2007

Acting as a Trial Judge in this designated International Synchronized Skating Competition will be considered as the required activity for present International Judges/Referees. Those ISU Members needing to provide activity either for their present International Judges/Referees or their National Judges who before April 15th, 2007 will be nominated by the respective ISU Members as International Synchronized Skating Judge, must send applications to the ISU Secretariat with a copy to the assigned member of the ISU Synchronized Skating Technical Committee, Mrs. Helen Volgushev, not later than December 22nd, 2006. As the total number of participants of the Trial Judging is restricted, the ISU Synchronized Skating Technical Committee will make the final selections from the applications submitted.

Program:

The Trial Judging will consist of different parts of Short Program and/or Free Skating in Senior and Junior categories.

All participants must plan to arrive at the official hotel on Thursday February 1st, 2007 before 16.30hrs and must plan to leave Rouen on Sunday February 4th, 2007 after 12.00hrs.
