Purpose:

The focus of this seminar will be on the changes to the Element Levels and clarification of the application of the Technical requirements by the Technical Panel.

Each Member may enter their International or ISU Technical Controllers or Technical Specialists **by September 13, 2011**. In addition, each Member may also enter one or two additional National level Technical Controller or Technical Specialist.

This refresher seminar is open for those officials who did not attend the Frankfurt seminar in July 2011. However this seminar will not count as a Re-Certification seminar.

Elite Level Coaches up to an agreed number may also participate in this seminar for the purpose of additional education. The number of participants is limited to 40; however a minimum of 10 participants is required.

From CDG Airport, 16 trains per day, direct to Lyon Part-Dieu Railway Station.
