Clarification to ISU Communication 1873, 1892 and 1905 as a result of the Vierumakki Officials seminar

Clarification to ISU Communication 1905 – page 3, 4 (Weaving Feature for Rotating Element (C) and Traveling Element (C))

All skaters must weave at the same time. If four (4) or more skaters do not weave at the same time during one (or both) occasions; weaving is not counted

Reason: To clarify and correct the call, when all skaters do not weave at the same time

Clarification to ISU Communication 1905 – page 5 (NHE – Series of Twizzles)

- Twizzle rotations are counted based on the number of correctly executed rotations.
 - Example: Team attempts to execute a triple twizzle with four (4) skaters or more correctly executing double twizzles. A double twizzle will be counted

Clarification to ISU Communication 1892 – page 8 (Pivoting Linear (Block Line))

ELEMENT		Reduce by	No higher than	Increase by
Pivoting/Linear (Block / Line)	<u>Pivoting Line Element not straight for most of the time during pivoting</u>		-1	
	<u>Linear Line(s) Element, not straight for most of the time and except during features and transitions</u>		-1	

Reason: The two (2) line elements cannot be evaluated with the same wording due to the fact that they are required to include different criteria. The current wording would not permit teams to execute features where the line shape momentarily disappears or to change axis without pivoting
