### Decision of the ISU Appeals Commission

The ISU Appeals Commission, following a hearing held in Lausanne on August 30, 2005, in the case of appeals filed by Judit Fürst-Tombor, Janet Garden, Britta Lindgren, Sally-Anne Stapleford, Jon Jackson, Ronald Pfenning against the decisions of the ISU Council on the eligibility of the Appellants dated March 24, 2005, has issued the following **Final Decision**:

1. The decision by the ISU Council dated March 24, 2005, concerning the Eligibility of the Appellants is upheld.
2. The Appeals of Judit Fürst-Tombor, Janet Garden, Britta Lindgren, Sally-Anne Stapleford, Jon Jackson, Ronald Pfenning are denied.
3. In accordance with Article 15 ISU Appeals Commission Rules of Procedure, each party bears their own costs.
4. There is no further appeal within the ISU from this decision. In accordance with Article 23, paragraph 1, of the Constitution an Appeal may be lodged with the Court of Arbitration for Sport in Lausanne, Switzerland within 21 days from the communication of the decision to the party.
