OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES 2006 ENTRIES/PARTICIPATION SINGLE & PAIR SKATNG AND ICE DANCING

(in addition to Communication No. 1313 and Circular Letter No. 597)

A) Entries

1. Allocated entries

The remaining entries for the Single & Pair Skating and the Ice Dancing competitions at the 2006 Olympic Winter Games (OWG) have been allocated according to Rule 400, paragraph 4, and Rule 570, paragraph 4, after the Karl Schäfer Memorial, Olympic Qualifying Competition in Vienna, Austria, held on October 12-16, 2005.

Only NOCs/Members which had not already qualified for entries in each discipline were eligible for the remaining entries for the 2006 Olympic Winter Games.

Entries to 2006 Olympic Winter Games are in all cases awarded to NOCs/Members and not individual/named skaters.

3. Qualification for Final Free Skating Ladies and Men

Based on the results of the Short Program in Singles and in accordance with Rule 379, paragraph 1, the twenty-four (24) best placed competitors only shall qualify for the Final Free Skating. The results shall be calculated in the usual manner in accordance with Rules 353.

The Israel Ice Skating Federation has announced that they will not send any Men to the OWG. Therefore this entitles the Slovak Figure Skating Association to one entry in the Men event.

The Polish Figure Skating Association has announced that they will send only one Pair to the OWG. Therefore this entitles The Figure Skating Federation of the Republic of Uzbekistan to one entry in the Pairs event.

The Bulgarian Skating Federation has announced they will send only one Ice Dance couple to the OWG. Therefore this entitles Hungarian National Skating Association to one entry in the Ice Dance event.

C) Entry procedures/deadlines

• November 30, 2005: Entry by Number forms must be submitted by all NOCs/Members which have been allocated an entry to the OWG, including those with stand-by entries. These forms must be sent by NOCs/Members and received by TOROC no later than November 30, 2005, according to their instructions and a copy must also be sent to the ISU Secretariat. In the case that not all NOCs/Members use their full quota of entries, the available places will be reallocated to the stand-by NOCs/Members. The respective stand-by NOCs/Members will be informed by the ISU immediately after November 30, 2005.

- January 23, 2006: Entry by Name forms (see attached) must be sent by all NOCs/Members which have been allocated an entry to the OWG, including those with remaining stand-by entries, and be received by the ISU Secretariat only, no later than January 23, 2006. In the case that not all NOCs/Members use their full quota of entries and the available entries are reallocated to NOCs/Members with remaining stand-by entries, the NOCs/Members receiving these reallocated entries will be informed by the ISU Secretariat by January 27, 2006.
- January 30, 2006: TOROC Entry by Name forms must be submitted by all NOCs/Members which have been allocated an entry to the OWG. These forms must be sent by NOCs and received by TOROC no later than January 30, 2006 according to their instructions and a copy also sent to the ISU Secretariat. After this date, in principle no entries can be transferred from one NOC/Member to another NOC/Member.
