## **1. GENERAL REGULATIONS**

The **Trophée des Petits Prodiges** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2014, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single Skating and Ice Dance 2014, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 c) for novice.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 1420 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must to be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation.

## **2. TECHNICAL DATA**

### **PLACE**

**Main arena Le Rochas 38114 Vaujany**

(an indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 30 x 60 m, air-conditioned and heated)

### **ADVANCED NOVICE AND BASIC NOVICE**

The required elements to be skated are those listed in the ISU Communication n°1947

## **3. TROPHY BY TEAM**

All members participate in the classification by team, if they are represented in, at least, 4 categories amongst in advanced and basic novices.

The team placed who obtain lowest points will receive a prize money of 5000 €. Results will be calculated as follows: For each team, the best placed skaters will score some points which are added to make the ranking.

For each category :

1st place	1 pt
2nd place	2 pts
3rd place	3 pts
4th place	4 pts
5th place	5 pts
6th place	6 pts
7th place	7 pts
8th place	8 pts
9th place	9 pts
10 <sup>th</sup> place	10 pts

#### **4. ENTRIES**

Each ISU member has the right to nominate 2 competitors for each event and one judge if the member has entries in two disciplines.

Each Entry Form must be signed by an authorized ISU Member Representative such as President, General Secretary, Executive Director, CEO (Rule 104, paragraph 4). For more details, please refer to Rules 115, 131, 378 and ISU Communication No. 1628 or any update of this Communication.

Preliminary entries indicating the number of skaters & judges in the disciplines concerned must be made not later than November 20, 2015.

Entries by name must reach the organizer not later than December 15, 2015.

Entry fees : 50 € for single skater and 80 € for ice dance couple.

#### **5. MEALS, LODGING EXPENSES**

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for one Judge participating, beginning with dinner on **February 2, 2016** until breakfast on **February 6, 2016**

The organizer will provide transfer from airport to hotel. Please accept that we have to ask for a small transportation fee from all persons participating in this shuttle service. Please inform the Organizing Committee together with your entry whether you will be using the transportation offered.

## **6. PRACTICE**

Official practice for Competitors begins on **February 3, 2016** The detailed schedule will be issued at the time of registration.

## **7. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT**

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on CD in any other approved format, in accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 1. A list of titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program for Single for the Short and Free Dance Program for Ice Dance and for the Exhibition must be listed for each Competitor on the official Music Selection Form and attached to the official Entry Form for Competitors.

In accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 1, all covers/discs must show the Competition event, Competitor's name, the Nation and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal and must be submitted at the time of registration. Each program (short program, free skating, short dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate disc. In addition, competitors/couples must provide a back-up drive for each program.

With the entry forms, the "Program Content Sheet" must be returned to the Organizing Committee in time. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet must be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

## **8. ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS / TEAMS**

All Referees, the Technical Panel (Technical Controller, Technical Specialists, Data & Replay Operator) Judges, Competitors, Team Leaders, Team Officials, Team Medical Staff and Coaches as well as the ISU Doping Control Team taking part in the competition are requested to announce to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible but no later than **December 15, 2015** the name of the airlines, flight numbers, dates and times of arrival at the **Lyon Saint Exupéry (LYS)** or any other information concerning transportation and arrivals. The official "travel form" should be used.

The nearest airport to **Grenoble** is **Lyon Saint Exupéry (LYS)** with a distance of about **1h30** by car to the official hotels. The Organizing Committee provides a bus shuttle to meet the teams on arrival. Please accept that we have to ask for a small transportation fee of 50 € from all persons participating in this shuttle service. Please inform the Organizing Committee together with your entry whether you will be using the transportation offered.

## **9. ACCREDITATION**

The official accreditation for Teams is planned at the ice rink upon arrival.

Accreditation as a Team Member will be given to all entered Judges, Competitors and one Team Leader per participating team, one Coach per Competitor, a maximum of two Team Officials of ISU Members (including the Member President).

Chaperons will not receive accreditation.

## **10. RESULTS**

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single Skating 2014, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

## **11. PRESENTATION OF MEDALS**

The three best placed Skaters/Couples in each event will be announced and honored. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medalists. The national anthem of the winner will be played and the flags of the medal winners hoisted.

## **12. INSURANCE / LIABILITY**

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each Member participating in ISU Events, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

The ISU assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.

## **13. EXHIBITION**

There will be an Exhibition for the medalists and additional invited skaters held on February 5 at 20:30
