THE CITY

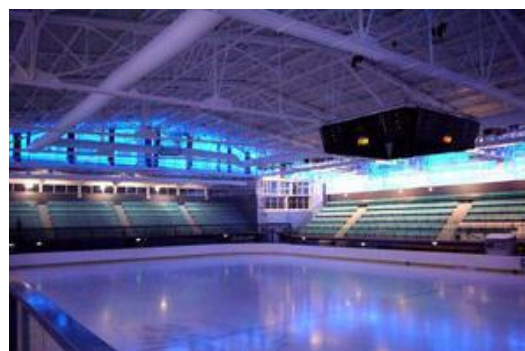
Saint Gervais is a ski Winter, located in the Haute Savoie's department. You can admire the highest mountain in France, the Mont Blanc 4810 meters.

TRAVELLING TO SAINT GERVAIS

By Plane:

The nearest airport to Saint Gervais is Geneva with a distance of about 2 hours by car to the official hotels.

The fee for the pick-up service is 60.00 € per person and need to be paid upon arrival at accreditation.

EVENT SHUTTLE

Shuttle-Bus-Service will connect the official hotels with the ice rink and return from the first practice day on (Wednesday, August 24, 2016).

The shuttle will run in accordance with the final time and practice schedule. A detailed bus schedule will be distributed at the time of registration.

REGISTRATION

Accreditation as a Team Member will be given to all entered Judges, Competitors and one Team-Leader per participating team, one Coach per Competitor, a maximum of two Teams Official of ISU Members (including the Member President), provided that they are Council Members, Technical Committee Members or Members of the Head Office of their Federation and a maximum of two medical persons. Accreditations will only be granted to persons in those various functions it officially entered and named through their National Association. The ISU Member certifies with the signed entry from the indicated functions within the team of the all team members. Any misuse of any function will be sanctioned by the ISU/OC.

Accreditations will be given to appointed ISU Event Officials, ISU Office Holders and Guests.

Passports of the skaters have to be presented at the accreditation for verification!

The registration for all teams will be held at the ice rink upon arrivals.

Accreditation will start on Tuesday, August 23 at 10:00 AM.

Chaperones

Officially entered chaperons (one per skater) can be accredited and have access to all practice sessions, competitions and to join the event shuttle bus system.

Chaperones accreditation are available at a price of 35 € from the accreditation desk at the ice rink.

ANTI-DOPING CONTROLS

The Anti-Doping tests will be conducted in accordance with the current ISU Anti-Doping Rules & Procedures (ISU Communications No. 1922 and 1970 or any further update of this Communication).

The tests will be taken from each first placed Skater/Couple. In case of a Couple it will be determined by draw whether the Lady or the Man of the first placed Couple will be tested.

One Skater from the remainder of the Skaters shall be selected by random draw in Men, Ladies and Ice Dance. In case of a Couple it will be determined by draw whether the Lady or the Man will be tested.
