1. Seminar for Officials serving at ISU World Synchronized Skating Championships 2017 and ISU Synchronized Skating Junior World Championships 2017

The seminar will take place in:

on November 17-20, 2016

This initiative is intended to assist our Officials in the preparation for their duties at the ISU World Synchronized Skating Championships in 2017 and ISU Synchronized Skating Junior World Championships 2017.

This will be an intensive seminar to update all Officials with the latest rules and regulations applicable to the upcoming major Events. The ISU wants to ensure to giving the support to Skaters in Synchronized Skating that they deserve by having knowledgeable and well-trained Officials evaluating their performances. Judging and technical officiating opportunities are few and many ISU Officials may only participate at the World Championship in a season. We feel it is important to give the Referees, Judges and Technical Officials as much practical guidance as possible for their important duty at the most important ISU Events.

Participants:

The candidates for the seminar are those Judges appointed by their ISU Member that have been drawn to participate at the ISU World Synchronized Skating Championships 2017 and ISU Synchronized Skating Junior World Championships 2017. Also, those Officials who have been appointed to act as Referees, Technical Controllers or Technical Specialists are invited to participate.

The applications to participate must be submitted by the ISU Member concerned, on behalf of their Judges, to the ISU Secretariat, to Mr. Christopher Buchanan, Chair of the ISU Synchronized Skating Technical Committee, to Ms. Krisztina Regöczy, ISU Sports Director and to the Finnish Figure Skating Association by **October 28, 2016**.

Seminar:

The Seminar will consist of two parts: a practical part with on-ice-demonstrations and practical instructions by ISU Moderators and a high standard Synchronized Skating team, a trial judging of a Synchronized Skating competition (Short Program and Free Skating) and a classroom lecture, which will consist of updates regarding Synchronized Skating rules and the judging system criteria (from the Special Regulations for Synchronized Skating 2016 and all pertinent ISU Communications) as well as in depth discussion regarding the application of the technical and judging rule sets.

This is not an examination and is intended as an intensive preparation for all Officials to help in the preparation to undertake their duties at the forthcoming World Championships. Participation in the seminar counts as such according to ISU Regulations 807, paragraph 9. c), 813, paragraph 5. b) ii), 814, paragraph 4. b) ii) and 818, paragraph 9. c).

Travel Contribution:

In line with usual ISU practice, up to the following amounts will be reimbursed on production of travel receipts. The ISU will only reimburse the cost of economy class travel.

Expenses:

The responsibility for the expenses of the Seminar will be allocated as follows:

- The living expenses (accommodation and meals) for the attending Officials from the evening of Thursday, November 17, 2016 to lunch on Sunday, November 20, 2016 will be borne by the ISU.
- Airport transfers will also be arranged provided the agreed prior notification of travel arrangements is received by the organisers.
- The travel expenses of the participating Officials will be reimbursed by the ISU, subject to submission of an actual ticket receipt up to a limit of:

2. Technical “Refresher” seminar

Purpose:

The purpose of this “refresher” seminar is to **update** the Technical Panel Officials with practical and theoretical instruction of the clarifications for the 2016-17 Synchronized Skating season (pertinent ISU Communications and Summary of calls).

The focus of this seminar will be on the introduction of New Elements and clarification of the application of the technical requirements by the Technical Panel.

Participants are part of and will attend the Technical Panel stream indicated on the timetable.

Participants / Applications:

Each ISU Member may enter their Technical Controllers or Technical Specialists with the qualification “International” and/or “ISU” (not those drawn for the ISU World Synchronized Skating Championships 2017 and ISU Synchronized Skating Junior World Championships 2017) **by October 28, 2016.**

This refresher seminar is NOT open for those Technical Controllers and Specialists who attended the Frankfurt seminar in July 2016.

The number of participants is limited to 10, however, a minimum of 5 participants is required.

Note: This seminar does not count as an official Re-Certification seminar

EXPENSES for the ISU “Refresher” Seminar:

- a) The travel and living expenses of the Moderators of the seminars, designated to serve by the SySTC, will be borne by the ISU.
- b) The travel and living expenses (accommodations and meals) for all participants who wish to attend this seminar are to be borne by their respective ISU Member or by the Officials themselves.
- c) All participants must pay a lump sum of **EUR 430 (or EUR 330 if sharing)**. This amount includes the payment of dinners on November 17, 18, 19, lunches on November 18, 19, 20 2017 (beverages are not included) and all coffee breaks and accommodation. A limited number of Double rooms are available for delegates wishing to share, but these will be booked on a first come first served basis.
- d) This lump sum must be paid on site in Euros (cash) by all participants at registration.
- e) The administrative expenses of the Seminar (ice rink, use of classroom and technical equipment) will be borne by the ISU.

All participants are responsible for arranging their own travel. Please note it is not possible to attend the seminar and not stay on-site.
