### 9. Sport Entries

#### 9.1 Eligibility

Participation in the SEAGF Games 2017 are open to accepted “Members” of the National Olympic Committee of the South East Asian Games Federation which are also a member of ISU, are entitled to enter athletes in each event. All skaters in the SEA GAMES 2017 must be a national of the country of the NOC which is entering such competitor. All matters relating to the determination of the country which a skater may represent shall be resolved by the Council of the SEAGF 2017.

Age requirement: To be eligible for participation in the SEA Games 2017, Athletes must COMPLY with the ISU Senior Level requirements. (i.e., to be at least 15 years old by July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017).

## **10. Event Officials**

Based on the request by SEAGF, the Ice Skating Association of Malaysia (ISAM) will invite Officials (Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data & Replay Operators) who meet the qualifications for single in accordance with the ISU Rule 420. The SEAGF reserves the right to propose the appointment of any Referees and Technical Officials via ISAM with justified reason.

## **12. Protest and Appeals**

Any protests regarding competitions shall be resolved under the ISU Constitution and General Regulations. Any disputes not resolved under the ISU Constitution and General Regulations or the SEAGF Constitutions and Rules may be referred to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS).

## **13. Equipment and Clothing**

## **14. Doping Control**

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the Regulations of South East Asian Games Federation and the ISU Anti-Doping Code, as given in the applicable ISU Communications (ISU Communications No. 2056 or later updates) and will definitely comply with the World Anti Doping Code (WADA) and also local Anti Doping (ADAMAS) and its relevant International Standard. In collaboration with the Medical Committee of SEAGF, MASOC will arrange the resources to handle the investigation of any cases involving disorders of sexual determination. The need for related tests and the processes to be followed will be as per rules/procedures laid down by the SEAGF

## **15. Victory Ceremony**

After competitions, victory ceremonies will be held at competition venues to honour the three best-placed Skaters in each event will be announced and honoured. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to individuals ranked first, second and third. The national anthem of the winner will be played and the flags of the medal winners hoisted. Further procedure will comply with the Constitution and Rules of the South East Asian Games Federation.

## **16. Media Interview**

Interviews by the local and international media will be conducted accordingly. Athletes must show their cooperation in the said media interview based on SEAGF rules and regulations.

## **17. Sport Information Centre (SIC)**

The main media that hosted the SIC will be at the National Stadium Bukit Jalil and a sub SIC will be located at the media centre at Empire City Mall Ice Rink.

## **18. Draws – Order of Skating**

### **Short Program**

The draws to determine the starting order shall be conducted in accordance with the Rule 513 paragraph 1 .

### **Free Skate**

The starting order for Free Skate will be in the reverse order of the first segment competition result. In case of tie, a draw will be done to determine the order.

## **19. Liability**

In according with Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each participating member participating in SEAGF Games 2017, to provide medical and accident insurance for the athletes, officials and all other members of the member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and the return of the ill or injured person to home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. Any related costs involved will be responsible by the participating member.

The ISU, the Organizing Committee and the Organizing Member of SEAGF Games 2017 assume no responsibilities for or liability with respect to any bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred of any competitor, official and other participant in connection with the competition.

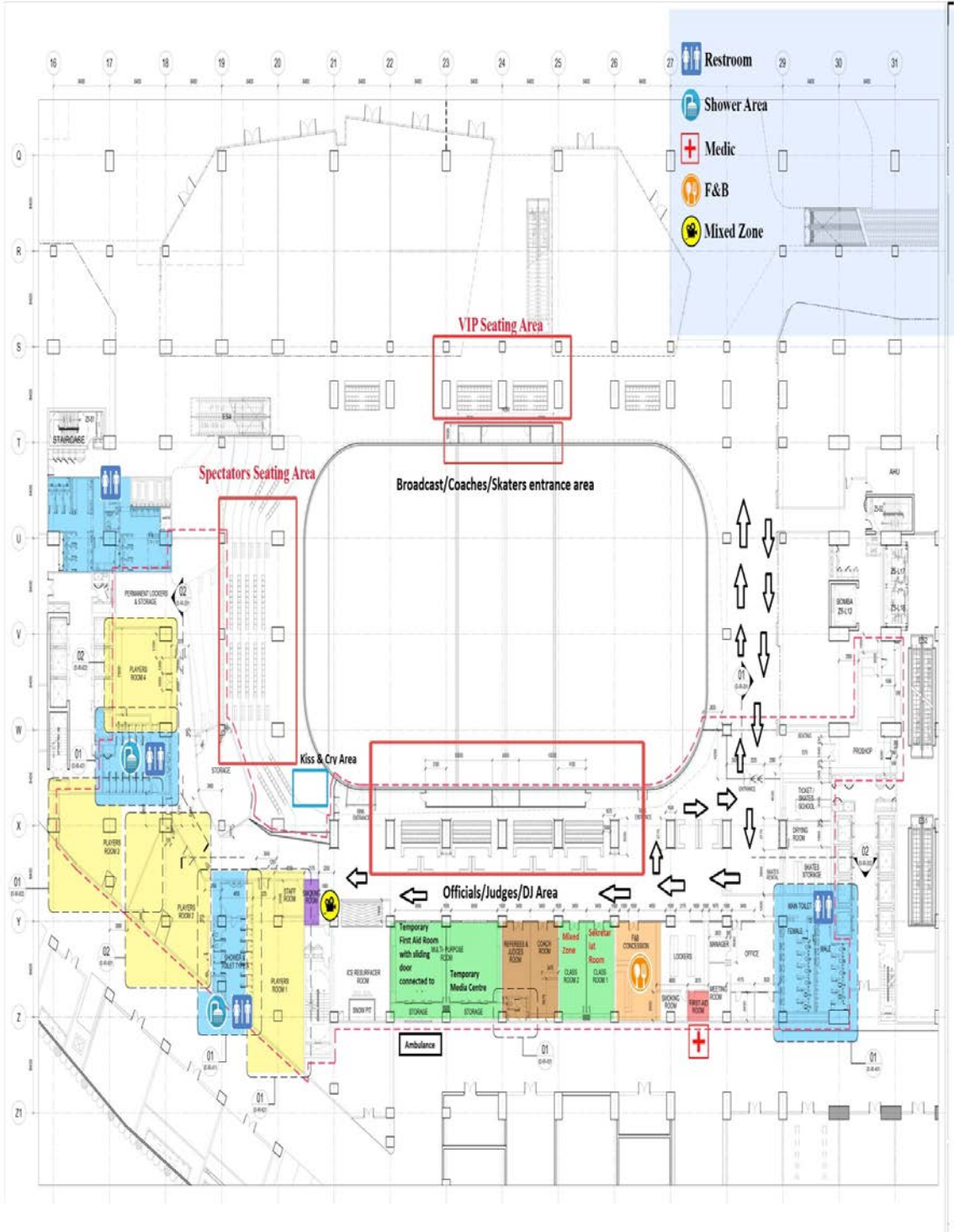

## **Appendix C**

### **1. Competition and Technical Rules**

- 1.1 The 29<sup>th</sup> SEA GAMES 2017 Figure Skating Competition will be conducted in accordance with the following Technical details and the ISU Judging System will be used for results calculation.
- a) The Figure Skating Competition of 29<sup>th</sup> SEA GAMES Kuala Lumpur 2017 will be conducted in accordance with the Constitution of the South East Asian Games Federation, the International Skating Union Constitution and General Regulations 2016, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2016 as well as the pertinent ISU Communications.
  - b) The total score of each segment is calculated by adding up the Technical Elements Scores and the Factored Program Component Scores after subtracting any program deductions.
  - c) The total scores of the Short Program and Free Skating are added and the results constitute the final score of a competitor in an event. The participant with the highest total final score in each category wins.
- 1.2 Disciplines: Men's singles and Ladies' singles

The elements, requirements and duration for Men and Ladies are as follows:

In accordance with ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2016.

#### **(I) Senior Men**

##### **Short Program**

- a) Double or triple Axel Paulsen;
- b) Triple or quadruple jump immediately preceded by connecting steps and/or by other comparable Free Skating movements;
- c) Jump combination consisting of a double and a triple jump or two triple jumps or a quadruple jump and a double jump or a triple jump;

- d) Flying spin;
- e) Camel spin or sit spin with only one change of foot;
- f) Spin combination with only one change of foot;
- g) Step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

Duration: 2'40"±10"

#### Free Skating

A well balanced Free Skating program for Senior Men must contain:

- a) Maximum of 8 jump elements (one of which must be an Axel type jump).
- b) Maximum of 3 spins, one of which must be a spin combination, one a flying spin or a spin with a flying entrance and one a spin with only one position.
- c) Maximum of 1 step sequence.
- d) Maximum of 1 choreographic sequence.

Duration: 4'30"±10"

#### (II) Senior Ladies

##### Short Program

- a) Double or triple Axel Paulsen;
- b) Triple jump immediately preceded by connecting steps and/or by other comparable Free Skating movements.
- c) Jump combination consisting of double jump and a triple jump or two triple jumps.
- d) Flying spin.
- e) Layback/sideways leaning spin or sit or camel spin without change of foot.
- f) Spin combination with only one change of foot.
- g) Step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

Duration: 2'40"±10"

##### Free Skating

A well balanced Free Skating program for Senior Ladies must contain:

- a) Maximum of 7 jump elements (one of which must be an Axel type jump).
- b) Maximum of 3 spins, one of which must be a spin combination, one a flying spin or a spin with a flying entrance and one a spin with only one position
- c) Maximum of 1 step sequence
- d) Maximum of 1 choreographic sequence.

Duration: 4'00"±10"

## **Appendix D**

### **Competition Format**

Figure Skating comprises two events – Men and Ladies

#### **Men**

- Two competition segments: Short Program and Free Skating;
- Each NOC of SEA Games who are also a Member of ISU can send maximum 2 skaters to SEA Games 2017;
- Skater with highest Total Score in Short Program and Free Skating win.

#### **Ladies**

- Two competition segments: Short Program and Free Skating;
- Each NOC of SEA Games who are also a Member of ISU can send maximum 2 skaters to SEA Games 2017;
- Skater with highest Total Score in Short Program and Free Skating win.

#### **Entries of Judges**

Each Member country of NOC may enter no more than 2 judges with qualification in the category no less than International Judge in Single & Pair Skating (as listed on ISU Communications No. 2027 and 2045) depending on the entries. The final list of invited judges will be determined by OC SEAGF in accordance with ISU rules. Each panel of Judges will consist of a maximum of 9 Judges but with a minimum of 5 Judges, if possible. A list of Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists Date/Replay Operator and invited judges will be confirmed by the

Detailed entry forms including names of the Judges must be submitted by each National Olympic Committee no later than 24:00 on January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017 (Malaysian Time) to OC SEAF.

Detailed entry forms including names of participants must be submitted by each National Olympic Committee no later than 24:00 (Malaysian Time) on May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017 to OC SEAF.
